*Passports must have at least 6 months' expiration date to travel to Cuba

*Passengers and crew born in Cuba are not allowed to travel by personal or non-commercial vessel to Cuba

Please note: Carlson Maritime Travel is licensed by OFAC (Office of Foreign Asset Control) to provide travel to, from, and within Cuba for U.S. citizens and those under U.S. jurisdiction for persons who are licensed to travel either under general or specific license. Vessels without prior written approval for stays longer than 14 days may travel with Carlson Maritime as we have a Department of Commerce license for Cuban export. Any permit from the U.S. Coast Guard does not constitute permission to engage in any activity that may be contrary to applicable U.S. laws of that foreign state.
